- \* All dairy and eggs must be accompanied by a Food Safety Certificate from the Country of Origin and issued by a Competent Authority.
- \* Imported dairy and eggs must be inspected by an Agricultural Inspector as well as a Bahamas Customs officer before being released.
- \* Egg permits are only valid for importing shell eggs for consumption only.
- \* The Food Safety Certificate must not be issued more than seven (7) days prior to shipment.
- \* Consignments not listed and/or exceeding quantities stated on the import application, invoice and Food Safety Certificate, will be confiscated and destroyed.
