- \* Imported meats and poultry must be inspected by an Environmental Health Inspector, as well as an Agricultural Inspector and Bahamas Customs officer before being released.
- \* The Food Safety Certificate must not be issued more than seven (7) days prior to shipment.
- \* Consignments not listed and/or exceeding quantities stated on the import application, invoice and Food Safety Certificate, will be confiscated and destroyed.
