## Conditions for approval

1. An application for imports of plants, plant products and other regulated articles must be made prior to purchase. **This application however does not guarantee the issuance or approval of an import permit.**
2. A valid import permit must be issued prior to import.
3. Some consignments may be subjected to a pest risk assessment (PRA) which may result in the delay of application processing time.
4. A phytosanitary certificate must be issued prior to shipment by the National Plant Protection Organization (NPPO) of the exporting country and should accompany the consignment(s), attesting to the phytosanitary measures established for that commodity by The Bahamas.
5. All commodities must be clean of good quality and found to be free from quarantine pests, soil and foreign matter.
6. Consignments not listed and/or in excess of quantities stated on the import application, invoice and phytosanitary certificate, will be confiscated and destroyed.
7. The Plant Quarantine Officer can demand any further phytosanitary action for any consignment that is infected, diseased, infested or contaminated.
8. Upon arrival at a designated Port of Entry in The Bahamas, all plants, plant products or other regulated articles shall be declared following verification of documents and inspection by a Plant Quarantine Officer or Authorized Officer and a Bahamas Customs Officer prior to release.

10. Entry may be refused if the above conditions are not observed.
